Volunteer Opportunities

ACTIVITIES

Assist with various activities such as the jewelry making station, karaoke, etc.

BATHROOM ATTENDANT

Provide basic assistance in the restroom and oversight of restroom areas to ensure honored guest and volunteers are never alone.

BUDDY

Accompany and assist assigned guest throughout the evening, providing companionship and any assistance needed. Sit with their guest during dinner, dance with them, and participate in activities with them.

BUDDY CHECK-IN

Greet buddies, give them their name tags or lanyards, and direct them to their team leader. During event, these volunteers would be responsible for floating throughout the event to check on buddies and ensure everyone is having a safe, enjoyable time and have the support they need.

COAT CHECK

Greet guests, take their coats, label, and hang them. As guests leave, ask for their names and retrieve their coats. The coat check will also serve as the lost and found for the event.

FOOD SERVICE

Serve food in main event space and Respite Room and refill food warmers, snacks, and drinks.

GUEST REGISTRATION

Warmly greet guests, sign them in, give them their name tag or lanyard, and answer any questions they may have. Help guests connect with their honored guest for the evening.

MEDICAL

Please let us know if you are a certified EMS/EMT or practicing doctor or nurse.

PAPARAZZI

Stand along the red carpet and warmly treat the honored guest like celebrities and VIPs upon arrival.

PARKING

Maintain a parking pattern and direct traffic for easy vehicle entry and exit.

RED CARPET

Assist and announce each guest as they make their way down the red carpet and cheer them on.

RESPITE ROOM

Love the parents and caregivers by serving food, spending time together getting to know them, and being available to pray with them.

SECURITY AND SAFETY

Please let us know if you are an authorized member of local law enforcement

SENSORY ROOM

Spend time with honored guests who may be experiencing over-stimulation from the excitement of the event, interact with them by participating in sensory activities, singing, listening to calming music, or simply providing quiet space.

SET-UP

Assist with set up of the environment the day before and day of the event.

SOCIAL MEDIA PHOTOGRAPHER

Assist by capturing the evening through fun and candid photos.

VOLUNTEER TRAINING

Pick one day to attend: January 26, 6:30-8:00 pm or February 2, 6:30-8:00 pm

TEAR DOWN

Assist with tear down and resetting of all spaces used as parts of the event is completed, and at the conclusion of the event.

TRANSPORTATION/PARTY BUS DRIVER

Assist guests with limo rides, as well as assist guests at the entry and conclusion of the event to their vehicles. Help maintain safety in parking lot areas.

VOLUNTEER CHECK-IN

Greet volunteers, given them their nametags or lanyards and helping connect them with their area leaders.
