Jesus Appears to the Disciples (John 20:19-23)

QUESTIONS FOR SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION AND PERSONAL REFLECTION:

1. Have you ever received good news that changed everything for you? (IE: an acceptance to college, a marriage proposal, a new job, etc.) Share about that experience, how it felt and what it was like to adjust to that news.
2. It takes a while (all the way through Pentecost, and then some) for the disciples to understand the difference that the resurrection had made. Why do you think it was so difficult for them to understand? Do you think Christians today still struggle to live as though "the resurrection changes everything?"
3. Aaron shared that because of Jesus resurrection, we have a new identity, a new family, a new purpose and a new reality. Which of those "new" things stood out to you the most?
4. What in your life is different because you know that Jesus has defeated sin and death? Where would you like the group to pray for Jesus' victory and resurrection to become more real and active in your life?
