As we look forward to another exciting school year, we wanted to tell you about some changes coming to our Sunday night ministries (MSM and HSM). Our hope and heart for Sunday nights is that students have a fun space to build deeper relationships with friends, leaders and most importantly, God. To do this well, we feel it is necessary to change the time of HSM/MSM Sunday nights this fall from 4:00-6:00 pm to 5:00-7:30 pm.

Why make this change?

- Dinner Fellowship
 - By adding an additional thirty minutes, Sunday nights won't feel as rushed and will better reflect their priority.
 - Dinner is one of the most important components of our weekly ministry—breaking bread with one another!
- Preparation
 - We, as ministry leaders, need more time between church services and MSM/HSM to prepare properly for the evening.
 - This would allow a longer time for our worship teams to rehearse.
 - This also gives more time for you to be with family between Sunday mornings and evenings.
- Extracurriculars
 - We have noticed an influx in sporting events/other extracurricular activities happening in the early to midafternoon that prevent students from participating in MSM/HSM.
 - Hopefully this time push-back will allow for more students to attend MSM/HSM.
- Relationships
 - This simply gives us more time to do ministry in our small groups, longer time to dive into Scripture, and to invest in the next generation!
