QUESTIONS FOR SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION AND PERSONAL REFLECTION:

1. People brought their children to Jesus. What does it look like to “bring” children to Jesus today? Similarly, how does the home and the church partner together to remove things that would “hinder” children from experiencing Jesus?
2. Jesus prays for the children. Share some examples of language we can use to pray for and bless children in Jesus’ name.
3. Jesus says that “the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these”. What does Jesus mean by this statement and what can adults learn from it? Matthew 18:1-5 is key for allowing scripture to interpret scripture.
