Fifth Petition (1 John 1:5-10; 2:9-11)

QUESTIONS FOR SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION AND PERSONAL REFLECTION:

1. Aaron talked about our struggle to admit we need forgiveness, to believe we are forgiven, and to extend that forgiveness to others. Which of those is easiest for you? Which is hardest?
 - How are those three truths related? What happens when we struggle to believe one of them?
2. What does your practice of confession look like? How are you regularly making time to confess to the Lord, and to regularly hear the good news of your forgiveness in Christ?
3. Spend time in prayer for one another as a group. Ask God to help you experience forgiveness deeply. Pray for those who are experiencing a hard heart to come to true repentance. Pray for those experiencing crippling guilt and shame to know God's love and peace. And pray for those harboring grudges to experience freedom from anger through the power of the Gospel.
