Jesus Appears to Thomas (John 20:24-31)

QUESTIONS FOR SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION AND PERSONAL REFLECTION:

1. While Jesus had been raised from death, his disciples were still hiding behind locked doors due to their fear, betrayal, guilt, and uncertainty. What “doors” need to be unlocked in your life in order for you to experience the fullness and freedom of the resurrection?
2. History refers to the disciple in this story as “Doubting Thomas.” Yet Thomas was much more than his doubts. What negative word have you, or words have you allowed to define you?
3. By contrast, what words would Jesus use to describe you?
4. Why do you think it is significant that the risen Jesus has scars? Why do most people try to hide their scars, whether physical or emotional?
5. How might Jesus use your “scars” to minister to others?
