Jesus Appears to Peter (John 21:15-25)

## QUESTIONS FOR SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION AND PERSONAL REFLECTION:

1. What emotions do you imagine Peter was feeling in this story? What would you have been thinking if you were in his shoes?
2. Jesus uses a charcoal fire to recreate the scene of Peter's betrayal. Then he asks if Peter loves him three times—echoing Peter's three denials. Why do you think Jesus did this? What was the purpose of making Peter face this shame?
3. Read Hebrews 4:12. Have you ever experienced what this verse describes? When God uses His word to expose sin or pain in your life? What good came out of times like that?
4. Spend time praying as a group about pain and sin in your life now that needs to be exposed and then forgiven or healed by the Lord. If your group is comfortable, you can share these things with one another. If not, just take time praying for each other to seek God's restoration.
