Pentecost (John 14:15-27)

QUESTIONS FOR SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION AND PERSONAL REFLECTION:

1. Re-read what Jesus says about the Holy Spirit in John 14:15-27. What are all the things that Jesus says the Holy Spirit does and gives?
2. What in that list is new to you, or something you are less likely to think about as a role of the Holy Spirit?
3. Aaron shared a quote from another pastor, "Give the Holy Spirit credit for everything the Bible gives the Spirit credit for." What do you think that quote means? Why is it helpful?
4. Jesus describes the work of the Spirit in terms of personal experience AND objective truth. There are things about the Spirit that are true, regardless of how we feel. There are also feelings and thoughts that He says the Spirit will give us. Are you more of an objective truth kind of person, or a subjective experience kind of person? How do you think that impacts your relationship with God?
5. Spend time in prayer as a group, asking God to help you notice the Holy Spirit's role in your life this week.
