QUESTIONS FOR SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION AND PERSONAL REFLECTION:

1. Have you ever felt unqualified or "less than," like you were part of something where you didn't really belong? Have you ever felt like this as part of God's people or God's calling to something?
2. Have you ever felt disqualified for God's blessing, or to be a part of God's people, because of choices you made?
3. Read Genesis 28:10-15 and John 1:50-51.
 - Jesus seems to quote from Gen 28:12. What do you think he means by this?
 - When God reiterates his promise to Jacob, it's not just for Jacob. God reminds Jacob that the blessing is so that "all nations on earth will be blessed through you." How might Christians still forget this and keep God's blessing to ourselves?
